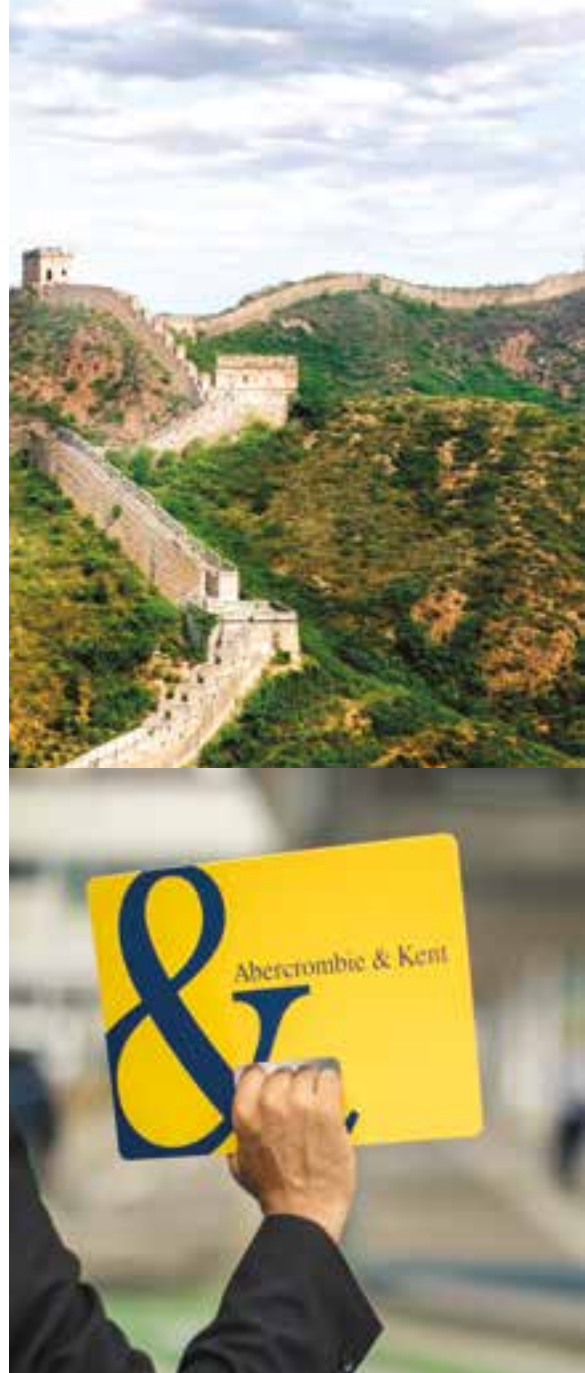

### DAYS 3-4: AMBOSELI NATIONAL PARK | ON THE PROWL

Depart for Amboseli National Park, famous for its big game and views of snow-capped Mount Kilimanjaro, the tallest freestanding mountain in the world. After lunch at your lodge and, perhaps, a lesson in spear throwing with your Child Activity Coordinator, it's time for a thrilling safari. 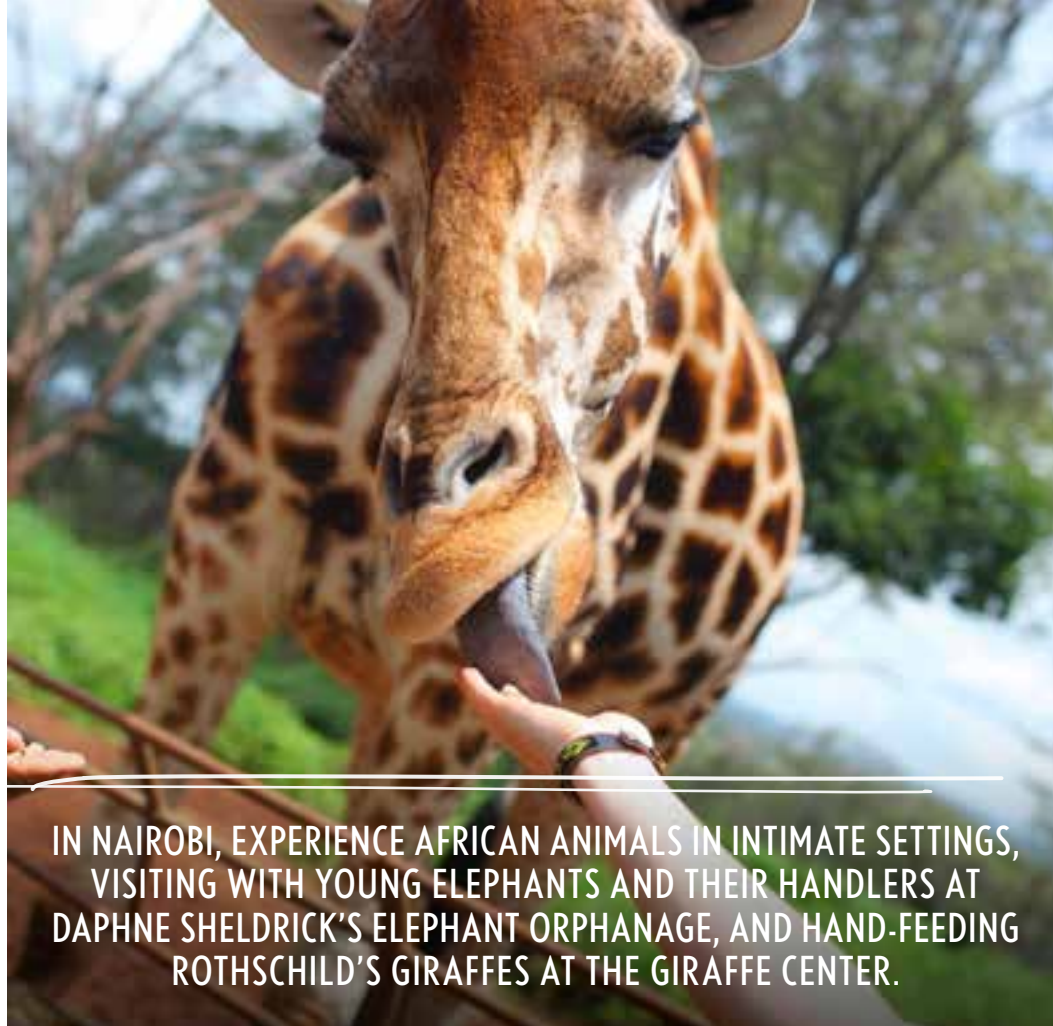

IN NAIROBI, EXPERIENCE AFRICAN ANIMALS IN INTIMATE SETTINGS, VISITING WITH YOUNG ELEPHANTS AND THEIR HANDLERS AT DAPHNE SHELDRIK'S ELEPHANT ORPHANAGE, AND HAND-FEEDING ROTHSCHILD'S GIRAFFES AT THE GIRAFFE CENTER.

Then, fly to Manyara and transfer to your lodge, perched on the rim of Ngorongoro Crater. A UNESCO World Heritage Site and "Lost World" of wildlife, Ngorongoro Crater was formed three million years ago when a giant volcano erupted and collapsed. Today, Ngorongoro is home to an incredible concentration of wildlife, including one of the highest densities of lions. Tonight, take in sweeping views from your own private balcony. The next day, ride into the lush expanse for a full day of game drives. Later, visit a Maasai village, where you meet with the village elder and learn how to make the tribal community's unique beaded jewelry.

Due to ship restrictions, women who will be six (6) months or more pregnant at any time during the cruise are not permitted to travel on Expedition Cruises.

## **A&K'S GUEST PROTECTION PROGRAM**

Travel insurance is not included in the price of the program and is recommended. You may purchase A&K's Guest Protection Program (which provides cancellation coverage, medical coverage and protection against lost or stolen or damaged luggage) or A&K's Guest Protection Program with Cancel for Any Reason Coverage for an additional fee. Due to the remote locations, A&K requires proof of a minimum of \$100,000 per person in emergency evacuation/repatriation insurance for all Antarctica, Arctic and Kimberley cruises. This minimum amount is included in the A&K Guest Protection Program; upgrades can be purchased for higher coverage on request.
